- APPELLATION : Grande Champagne, 1st Growth of Cognac
- GRAPE VARIETIES : Ugni Blanc, Colombard and Folle Blanche
- BLEND of around one hundred eaux-de-vie, selected for their finesse

■ AGED for more than two generations in special barrels called 'Tierçons' within the reknown Tesseron family's Paradis where the oldest cognacs are kept

- CHARACTER : Very rich, bold, great length on the palate, smooth. Great length on finish
- WHEN : Late at night with a Cuban cigar (Montecristo N°3)
- TEMPERATURE : 18–20°C
